

Alamo Heights Independent School District

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The District Education Advisory Council (DEAC) of the Alamo Heights Independent School District, a team comprised of a representative group of staff, parents and community members, is proposing a calendar for the 2018-2019 school year that satisfies statutory requirements and is also responsive to the unique needs expressed by our school community.

Previous state law requires districts to create a calendar that includes a minimum of 75,600 minutes of instruction for students. The draft calendar consists of 176 instructional days for students to satisfy required minutes, and an additional 11 days of staff development/work days for teachers and staff members, to satisfy contractual requirements for 187 days of service.

Annually, the DEAC solicits input from our school community about creating a calendar that is responsive to our local needs. Feedback from both the calendar survey last year, as well as our DEAC meetings include the requests for our calendar to include:

- An end of school date prior to the Memorial Day weekend
- A balance of instructional days in each semester to allow one-semester courses to cover the assigned curriculum
- An end of semester date that falls prior to the December holiday break
- A December holiday break that allows families to maximize the time for quality time together
- Allow for early release days for parent-teacher conference at the elementary level and for professional development to give teachers the time they need to better support their students

A new state law (HB 2442), changed the rules about "early release" and the required minutes of instruction. Therefore, in order to continue our tradition to offer parent – teacher conferences at the elementary level, DEAC is recommending the addition of 5 minutes to the elementary start time to provide the <u>required</u> minimum minutes of instruction total. Instead of starting at 7:50 AM, Howard will begin school at 7:45 AM. Instead of starting at 8:20 AM, Cambridge and Woodridge will both start school at 8:15 AM next year. There will be no changes made to the end time of dismissal at any of the campuses under this draft calendar.
