#### I. Welcome & Introductions

The meeting began at 11:31 AM with Dr. Alfaro welcoming the DEAC Committee and introducing each member and one guest attendee.

### II. Business and Planning

### A. DEAC purpose and function: Dr. Frank Alfaro

The DEAC has combined the councils and duties of the district SBDM committee, School Health Advisory Council (SHAC), and the district Technology Committee. The DEAC serves as the district site based decision making team. Members of the team were encouraged to communicate regularly with those groups they represent on the committee.

### B. Presentation and Discussion on Vaping - Dr. Frank Alfaro Discipline/Cat Wider Health Presentation

Dr. Alfaro shared information regarding a law established in the May 2023 Legislative session that requires mandatory placement in the district Discipline Alternative Education Placement (DAEP) for any student found with vape at school or at a school event.

Cat Widler provided an overview of vaping including the health risks, penalties, devices, substances, and common behaviors that may indicate use of a vape. Ms. Widler reinforced the importance of talking with your children and setting expectations.

### C. Presentation and Discussion on Artificial Intelligence (AI) - Brian Grenier

Mr. Grenier shared information about Artificial Intelligence (AI). Mr. Grenier discussed how AI works and examples of different tools available. K-12 AI hot topics for technology directors are AI basics, the future of AI, and ethical issues for schools.

K-12 AI hot topics for technology directors are AI basics, the future of AI, and ethical issues for schools. This fall, Dr. Walker and Mr. Grenier have conducted more than 30 meetings to discuss AI with teachers. AI is evolving quickly and there is a need to react now. DEAC committee members shared their personal experience with AI, concerns about AI, as well as positive ways to use AI with students.

Teacher committee members gave examples of how they are already seeing AI used by students, as well as how they are beginning to use AI as an educational tool in the classroom.

## D. Presentation and Discussion of AHISD Community-Based Accountability Pillar I (STAAR, AP scores) - Dr. Jimmie Walker

Dr. Walker presented data and information on how AHISD stands alongside the state and national levels in terms of student academic performance on STAAR and Advanced Placement (AP) exams. A review of changes that 2022-2023 STAAR underwent were shared with the committee. District focuses are math and writing. In the meeting, the members studied the data and provided feedback. Community-Based Accountability will be a part of future DEAC meetings.

E. Presentation & Discussion of TEA A-F Accountability Changes - Dr. Jimmie Walker Dr. Walker shared that TEA A-F Accountability Ratings have been delayed and are now anticipated to be issued in November of 2023. A review of methodology updates, progress measures, and changes to cut scores were also reviewed with the committee.
